Cookies and their use

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file placed on your computer's hard drive. It allows our website to identify your computer when you view different pages on our website.

How we use cookies

Store information about your preferences. The website can then present you with information that is more relevant and interesting to you.

To recognise when you return to our website. We may show you relevant content or provide features that you have previously used.

Cookies do not give us access to your computer or any information about you other than what you choose to share with us.

Controlling cookies
